The Green Team of Rolling Hills Wildlife Adventure would like to invite visiting classrooms to join us in our conservation efforts.

By collecting used cell phones and aluminum cans as a class project, you can do your part for the environment.

Activity sheets are included so students can learn more about recycling and also as a reminder to collect cans and cell phones. If one student brings in 33 cans - it is approximately equal to one pound!

All donated phones and collected aluminum cans are recycled by the RHWA Green Team as a fundraiser to aid in-house conservation projects.

In addition, 25% of all funds are contributed to the Orangutan Conservancy via the "Where in the World is Robbie B?" Ape Education & Awareness Project.
