Entry Fees

All entry fees are nonrefundable

Pre-registered entries:

- Deadline is 5:00 p.m., Monday, June 7th
- Entry fee is \$20

Check-in

Gate opens for check-in at 7:00 a.m.

Gate closes for check-in at 9:00 a.m.

Due to the popularity of our car show, we have over 4,500 guests that attend this event, as well as trams circulating through the Zoo. Zoo hours are 8:00 am-5:00 pm. Our responsibility of safety is not only for our guests, but for our exhibitors as well.

No exhibitor vehicles, including pre-registered entries, will be allowed inside the Zoo after 9:00 a.m. NO EXCEPTIONS! Don't be late!!

For the same reason, exhibitor vehicles will not be allowed to exit the Zoo until after presentation of awards.

Upon entering Rolling Hills' parking lot, exhibitors are required to drive up to the registration booth to check in. Do not park your vehicle and walk up to check-in! Registration is strictly drive-through this year.

If you wish to be parked in the Zoo next to a fellow exhibitor(s), wait in the parking lot until you have all arrived, then drive up together to the registration booth to check in.

Parking

Exhibitor vehicles will be escorted into the Zoo by Rolling Hills staff.

All car and truck entries will be parked for display inside the Zoo on the east and west lawns surrounding the lake (grass surface).

All motorcycles and bicycles will be parked for display in the Zoo at the Great Apes courtyard (asphalt surface).

Designated parking for trailers and tow vehicles will be in the grass lot past the public parking lot east of the Wildlife Museum.

Trailered vehicles may be unloaded in the public parking lot, but you must park your trailer and tow vehicle in the designated parking area before proceeding to the registration booth.

Rolling Hills staff will circulate with a golf cart to transport you quickly from the grass parking lot back to your exhibit vehicle in the public parking lot.

Judging & Awards

Judging begins at 9:30 a.m. and ends at 2:00 p.m.

Trophies and awards will be presented at the Overlook Patio (next to the restaurant) at 3:30 p.m.

1st and 2nd place awards are presented in each class.

New this year! Skip's Concessions inside the Zoo will be offering pulled pork and brisket sandwiches, chips, sodas, etc. (west side of the lake).
